Abstract: More than a decade has passed since the first attempt to revise and amend the supplementary electricity tariff regulations. Over the years, many problems have been raised by experts and pundits. Without entering into the accuracy or correctness of these problems, making it possible to record these opinions with the aim of exploiting them in research studies, decision-making and related decisions, special importance in line with knowledge management goals and the possibility of effective use of latent knowledge of these records has it. In this regard, Niroo Research Institute, with the order of the Deputy Minister of Electricity and Energy of the Ministry of Energy and with the aim of reviewing the existing conditions and proposing amendments to the new environment, is responsible for research management entitled Was hanged. In amending and codifying the mentioned by-laws, two general goals of creating more transparency and less interpretability of the provisions of the by-laws have been considered as basic principles. Also, ranking and grouping the provisions of the regulations with the aim of collecting and moving similar options in one category and category is another purpose of reviewing the regulations. Other issues such as: protection of mutual rights of customers and companies that own the network, adaptation to the new business environment (including considerations related to the supply of electricity to subscribers through bilateral contracts, energy exchanges and retailers, the presence of small-scale generators, roads Launching the market, capacity certificates, etc.) were among the issues that were tried to answer these ambiguities and questions by examining more carefully and expertly the relations of the new environment and its compliance with the provisions of the supplementary regulations on electricity tariffs and other existing infrastructure. And provide the necessary changes in order to complete the regulations.

In this regard, an attempt was made to prepare and process the records related to the above discussion in a coherent and systematic manner, in order to enable other researchers in this field to use them in the future, while using them in compiling an informative version, in line with knowledge management goals.
